



ACCESS FOR SPECTATORS WITH DISABILITIES

CEV FINAL FOUR

The Organizer is committed to ensuring an inclusive, safe and accessible experience for all spectators. Dedicated seating areas are available within the venue for spectators with disabilities, including spaces designed to accommodate wheelchair users and individuals with reduced mobility.

A limited number of seats is reserved for spectators with disabilities. FIPAV provides a dedicated service through which eligible individuals may request complimentary accreditation, subject to availability, for the match they wish to attend.

This service is available to spectators holding a certified disability of at least 74% (irrespective of the nature of the disability), as well as to individuals with severe disabilities. Each spectator with disabilities may be accompanied by one accompanying person, who is eligible to purchase a ticket at a reduced rate. The accompanying person must be at least 18 years of age.

Availability of reserved seating is limited and subject to the capacity of the venue for each match day.

Requests must be submitted exclusively via the designated booking form and must specify the relevant match day. All requests will be processed by the Organizer in chronological order of receipt (based on date and time of submission), until **30 April 2026** or until all available seats have been allocated.

All applicants will receive a response, including in cases where requests cannot be accommodated due to limited availability.



Submission of a request does not guarantee access to the Event. Access will be granted only upon receipt of a formal written confirmation issued by the Organizer.

The Organizer does not guarantee the availability of accessible parking spaces in the vicinity of the venue, nor the availability of spaces within any existing accessible parking areas nearby.

In the event of confirmation, tickets will either be sent by email or may be collected at the venue on the relevant match day (only tickets valid for that specific day may be collected). Tickets may be collected exclusively by the spectator with disabilities or by the accompanying person, upon presentation of a written authorization and a copy of a valid identification document.

Important: As availability is limited, each confirmed accreditation reduces the number of seats available to others. Applicants are therefore kindly requested to submit a request only if they reasonably expect to attend the Event.
